The qualifications assess the learners' competency in speaking, listening, reading, writing and use of English.

Are there set examination windows?

No, VTCT ESOL International qualification examinations are on demand and have multiple flexible windows. Examinations can be conducted at times that are suitable to Centres and learners; there are no assessment windows. This learner centred examination approach bolsters confidence in learning and assessment and supports all learners to fulfil their potential confidence.

Do learners need prior knowledge, skills, or experience to complete these qualifications?

There are no formal entry requirements for learners undertaking the qualifications.

Do learners have to complete all modes to gain the qualification?

Our assessments enable learners to be assessed in four core language skills; listening, speaking, reading, and writing – we call this 'All Modes' because we assess all these skills to determine the overall outcome and grade and be eligible for certification.

How are learners assessed?

VTCT (ITEC) ESOL International qualifications, learners are evaluated in several ways. Here is how it works; listening, reading, and writing modes of assessment are assessed by either a paper based or online examination which is externally set, and quality assured by VTCT (ITEC). The speaking mode of the qualification is assessed separately by dedicated in-house speech assessors and further quality assured by VTCT. Each speaking assessment is conducted one-on-one, ensuring a supportive experience that truly centres around learners'

How do I receive my learners results and certificates?

VTCT will take the administrative burden and will process result and certificates for the approved centres. These will be sent directly to the approved centre for distribution to the learners.

Can learners who fail retake the exams?

Learners who fail to achieve the required Pass mark are permitted to re-sit after having sufficient teaching and additional study time. There is no limit to the number of retakes a learner can attempt.

Can I apply for reasonable adjustments and special considerations for learners?

A reasonable adjustment is an adjustment made to an assessment for a qualification that is approved or set in place before an assessment activity takes place; it constitutes an arrangement to give the learner access to the qualification.
